SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1) The Bentley Drivers Club will organise a Clubmans/National B Race Meeting on Saturday 5th August 2017 at Silverstone National Circuit. This meeting is inscribed on the NCAFP.
- 2) The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and Supplementary Regulations and any written Instructions the organising Club may issue for the event.
- 3) MSA Permit Numbers: Clubmans: 98589 National B: 98590
- 4) The event is open to:

- 5) Competitors must hold MSA racing licences of National B or higher grade and (if applicable) Club membership cards. All these documents will be inspected at signing-on. Please note that competitors holding a licence not issued by the MSA can only participate with written authorisation from their ASN (article 18 FIA International Sporting Code). Drivers requiring signatures on their Upgrade Card should leave them with the organisers when signing-on. The circuit is Silverstone National Circuit, Northamptonshire and is 1.639 miles in length. The surface is sealed throughout and all racing will be in a clockwise direction.
- 6) Scrutineering will start at 07:45 hrs and practice at 09:00 hrs. The meeting will open at 09:00 hrs. Any competitor not signed on by 11:00 hrs may be excluded. Note that any amendments to times will be notified in final instructions, together with individual signing on, scrutineering and practice session times.
- 7) In the case of races in which the handicap is wholly or partly based on practice times, a driver who in any race lap improves upon his best practice lap time by more than 5% may be excluded (Q12.10.2).
- 8) The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations, and closes finally at 12:00 noon on **Wednesday 2nd August 2017**
- 9) There will be 9 races, as follows (note – this may NOT be the order, the order will be indicated in the “Final Instructions”).

- 12) The Secretary of the Meeting is Robert Williams. All entries must be sent to the Entries Secretary, at W.O. Bentley Memorial Building, Ironstone Lane, Wroxton, Banbury, Oxfordshire, OX15 6ED

- 13) The maximum entry for the meeting, including reserves, is 396; the minimum is 100. The maximum for each race is 40; minimum number per race is 10; minimum number per class is 2. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to either cancel the meeting, or amalgamate races, or classes, as necessary.
- 14) The opening date is on publication of the Supplementary Regulations. The closing date is 12:00 noon **Wednesday 2nd August**. In addition to the MSA Regulation [D 18 to 19] the organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
- 15) **Entries:** May be by Post, Fax, or other means. Any entry not accompanied by the correct entry fee is not a valid entry. A reduced entry fee applies up to 12:00 noon on **Wednesday 19th July**. The final deadline for entries is 12:00 noon **Wednesday 2nd August**, entries will be accepted after this time for Race 8A Allcomers Scratch, which will be taken up to 1hr before Qualifying for any car/driver combination already entered in to the meeting.
Bank charges for unpaid cheques etc. will be passed on to the competitor by the Club at the rate of £25 per transaction.
- 16) **Refunds:** Full refunds will only be given for any cancellations received by 12:00 noon on **Wednesday 2nd August**. No refunds will be given for any cancellations received after this deadline, even if you have an accident in testing in the days leading up to the event. Nominated reserves that do not get a race may be considered for a full refund.
- 17) **Driver/Vehicle Changes:** No change of driver and/or vehicle can be made without an application in writing to the Secretary of the Meeting, in accordance with MSA Regulations [D25.1.12.].
- 18) Other officials are:

- 19) Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each race, or following the end of the event and posted on the official notice board at the foot of the stairs in Race Control.
- 20) Protests: Any protests must be made in accordance with C5.
- 21) Starting positions will be in accordance with Q4.6.
- 22) Each driver will be given the opportunity to practice as per Q12.9.7.

- 23) Competitors will be identified by numbers on each side of the car and on the bonnet/front of the car. If competitors have not finished in 6 races prior to this meeting, then they must carry a novice cross at the rear of their car. Please note competition numbers will be available at 'sign-on' as per Q11.1.
- 24) All cars will be checked for sound levels, and must comply with the limits in J5.16 & J5.17.
G10.2.1. The Chief Scrutineer of an event and members of the Technical Commission are considered Judges in respect of Vehicle Eligibility (C.3).
G10.2.2. Environmental Scrutineers and Officials in charge of Sound Meters are considered Judges in respect of Sound.
- 25) Entries will be acknowledged within seven days of receipt as per D16.1, and any entrant not receiving an acknowledgement within this time should contact the Entries Secretary at once (H30 will apply). Acceptance of Entry will be sent via email, except where no email address provided. All entrants are requested to provide an email address for contact purposes.
- 26) All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations, and with any special requirements as notified in the SR's.
- 27) Each competitor is required to have a timing transponder as per Q12.2.1, which they will be required to fit to their car in such a place that it can send an uninterrupted signal vertically Downwards to the track. Transponders are available to hire on the day, for non BDC members a fee of £30 will apply, if required please indicate this on your entry form.
Competitors should be aware that any time keeping device hired from the organisers must be returned before leaving the circuit. In the event of said device being damaged, destroyed or not returned the Competitor will be liable for any replacement costs.
- 28) In the case of the abandonment or cancellation of the Meeting the organisers will retain sufficient of the entry fees in order that costs/expenses incurred shall be covered.
