Supplementary Regulations

1. The Classic Sports Car Club will organise and promote a Race Meeting at Snetterton on Saturday 28th and Sunday 29th March 2020.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations and any written Instructions the organising Club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK permit number, 116734 (Interclub)
This event is NCAFP inscribed.
4. The meeting is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club, members of the Jaguar Enthusiasts Club, and registered drivers in the AR Motorsport Morgan Challenge. See D,4.3.1.
5. Rounds of the following Championships will take place at this meeting:
Toyo Tires/Watchdogapp.com Jaguar Saloon & GT Championship . (Permit number:CH2020/R089). AR Motorsport Morgan Challenge. (Permit number: CH2020/099)
6. Competitors must hold Motorsport UK racing licences of Interclub or higher grade. Please note that competitors holding a licence not issued by Motorsport UK can only participate with written authorisation from their ASN (article 18 FIA International Sporting Code).
Drivers requiring signatures on their Upgrade Card should leave them with the Secretary Of The Meeting when signing-on and collect them 30 minutes after the race.
7. The Circuit is the Snetterton 300 Circuit and is 3miles (4.78km) in length. Racing will be in a clockwise direction.
8. Scrutineering will start at 07.00 for those in the garages. Qualifying starts at 09.00. The meeting will open at 07.00 each day. Any competitor not signed-on by 11.00 each day may be excluded.

If the same car and driver is registered for a second series and entered for a second race at this meeting, the entry fee for the second series race is reduced by £100. The 2nd CSCC Gold Arts Magnificent Sevens series race is already discounted to £170 for all cars and drivers already entered into the 1st race. Class Structure and Awards as per Series Regulations.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and **closes on Wednesday 25th March 2020**. To encourage early entry, all entries received after Sunday 15th March will incur an additional £30 fee. This also applies to second drivers in CSCC Series. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER WEDNESDAY 25th March 2020**. Drivers already entered into the meeting may enter the Verum Builders Open race up until one hour before qualifying for this race. **Registered CSCC & JEC drivers may enter and pay online using the ProSolve booking system** up until Thursday 19th March, all other entries must be made on the official form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. *To save administration time and costs, entries will be acknowledged by e-mail whenever possible. Please include your e-mail address on the entry form. E-mailed entry forms (complete with signature) must not contain credit/debit card details*, instead please call the office with these after e-mailing the form. Entry information may also be faxed or posted. Entry will only be accepted on receipt of the fee and properly completed form. Cheques should be made payable to Classic Sports Car Club Ltd. Entries will be selected to conform with H.30 and i) Registered Championship/Series contenders first and ii) entry forms received in chronological order. Entry fees will be refunded under the terms of H.31.1.2 if a competitor notifies the organiser **in writing, email or by FAX** by 5.00pm on Wednesday 25th March 2020. Up until 14 days before the race meeting a full refund will be given. Between 14 days before the race meeting and up until the closing date a £25 administration fee will be deducted from the entry fee refund. **There will be NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS after the closing date.**

11. The maximum number of starters in each race will be 45 and the minimum will be 10. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right either to cancel the meeting or the race or amalgamate qualifying, races or classes, or substitute races as appropriate.

13. Competition Numbers must be displayed in accordance with J.4.1/Q11.4. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that numbers are properly presented for scrutineering as per Q.11.1.1 and are clearly visible for practice and race.
14. Grid positions are determined by times recorded in official qualifying, except:
- In the Gold Arts Magnificent Sevens' second grid where the grid for the second race will be determined by the finishing order of the first race.
 - In the Toyo Tires/Watchdogapp.com Jaguar Saloon & GT Championship where the grid for the second race will be determined as per Championship regulations.
 - In the CSCC Verum Builders Open race where the grid position for the second part of the race will be determined by the finishing position in the first part of the race
- All other General Regulations of Motorsport UK apply as written.
15. **Rolling starts will be used for all races except the Toyo Tires/ Watchdogapp.com Jaguar and GT Championship with Verum Builders Open Series where there will be a separate standing start for the Open Series who will start by means of the National flag 20 seconds behind the Jaguars.(Q 12.14.2)** The starting signal for all other races will be given by lights. In the event of any starting lights failure the Starter will revert to use of the National Flag.
16. Provisional results will be announced as soon as possible after each race in Race Administration.
17. Protests. Entrants are reminded that protests should be made in accordance with Motorsport UK General Regulations C.5.1.
18. 95 RON Fuel supplies will be available at the circuit. There is a new petrol station just outside the circuit selling Super Unleaded.
19. Admission per single driver entry will be 4 Personnel passes. If part of a two driver team the second driver will receive an additional 2 personnel passes. No paddock vehicle passes are needed. Parking for private cars is limited. No animals are allowed.
20. In qualifying it is a competitor's responsibility to ensure that he/she completes the requisite number of laps. Some qualifying sessions may be amalgamated.
21. Parc Ferme will take place in front of the scrutineering bay, as directed by officials.
22. Judges Of Fact (G.10.2) will be named for: Judges, Technical, Timing, Flag infringements and Track Limits.
23. **Race engines must not be run before 08.30 on both days or after 18.45 on any day. Competitors not complying with this may be reported to the Clerk of the Course.**
24. Transponders will be required at this meeting as per Q.12.2.1. Please make sure your number is CLEARLY written on your registration/ entry form and let us know if it changes.
25. In the case of the abandonment or cancellation of races or the Meeting, the organisers will retain sufficient of the entry fees in order that costs/expenses incurred shall be covered.
